ENVISION-AESC GIGAFACTORY

Envision-AESC will invest in a second gigafactory, adjacent to Nissan Sunderland Plant, equipped with next-generation battery technology, supporting the continued localisation of vehicle parts and components.

BACKGROUND

- Nissan's long-standing battery partners, Envision-AESC already operates Europe's first gigafactory in Sunderland
- The formal planning process is about to begin to build a second gigafactory
- Located on the International Advanced Manufacturing Park (IAMP), adjacent to the Nissan Sunderland Plant
- Draws on 8 years of expertise from supplying batteries for the Nissan LEAF and e-NV200
- Builds on global benchmark levels of quality, safety and reliability
- Equipped with next-generation battery technology
- Created to support production of new EV model allocation
- Has potential for two further phases of growth
- Supports continued localisation of vehicle parts and components
- Helps makes Nissan EVs more accessible to more consumers

ENVISION-AESC GIGAFACTORY IN NUMBERS

- Envision-AESC will invest £450 million building a second gigafactory near Nissan Sunderland Plant
- Represents 9GW plant with the potential for two further phases of growth to increase production up to 35GW
- Creates 750 jobs at Envision-AESC
