NISSAN SUNDERLAND PLANT

Since Nissan Sunderland Plant opened in 1986, the plant has developed into an international automotive centre, located in Sunderland, UK.

BACKGROUND

- UK engineering, design and manufacturing capability **supporting 46,000 UK jobs**
- World-leading logistics operation managing 5 million parts a day
- Exports: 70% vehicles exported to EU, 20% UK, 10% exported outside EU
- 1 of only 3 Global Training Centres within Nissan
- Mother plant for AMIEO region

NISSAN SUNDERLAND PLANT IN NUMBERS

- **6,000 employees at Nissan Sunderland** Plant, 7,000 across the UK
- Supports over 46,000 jobs in the UK supply chain
- 2 production lines
- Models built:
 - o Line 1: Qashqai and LEAF
 - o Line 2: Qashqai and JUKE
- Produced 245,846 cars in 2020
- Since 1986, Nissan Sunderland Plant has produced **10.4m** cars
- More than **£5 billion** all time investment by Nissan
- **£400m** investment for the all-new Qashqai being produced at Nissan Sunderland Plant
- Fastest single site UK factory to produce 10 million units (2018)
- 1 in 10 cars built at Nissan Sunderland Plant last year was electric (72,745)
- **5,000 graduates, placements and apprenticeships** since 1986 and more than 65,000 North East youngsters have engaged with a Nissan Skills Foundation event at the plant
