## NISSAN SUNDERLAND PLANT – CURRENT LINE-UP



### NISSAN QASHQAI

- Nissan Qashqai represents one in five of all cars built in Britain since launch
- First generation launched in 2006 – pioneering the crossover market
- Second generation launched in 2014
- Third generation launched in 2021
- In 2022, Nissan Qashqai became the first model in Europe to be equipped with the e-POWER drive system
- Nissan Qashqai is designed, engineered and built in the UK
- Built on line 1 and 2 at Nissan Sunderland plant
- More than 3 million Nissan Qashqais have been sold in Europe to date
- Since launching, the Nissan Qashqai has contributed more than £2.8 billion to the UK economy through suppliers, wages and services
- 2023 UK production volume to end of October: 168,325
- Qashqai was best-selling car in the UK in 2022 – the first UK-built best-seller in 24 years
- In 2022, 42,704 Nissan Qashqais were sold in the UK, and in 2023 (until end of October), 34,952 have been sold in the UK



### NISSAN JUKE

- The Nissan JUKE – the original rule-breaker – was launched in 2010
- Second generation launched in 2019
- In 2022, the Nissan JUKE Hybrid began production at Nissan Sunderland Plant
- Since launching, over 1.3 million Nissan JUKES have been built
- The Nissan JUKE is designed, engineered and built in the UK and is built on line 2 at Nissan Sunderland Plant
- In 2022, 16,790 Nissan JUKES were sold in the UK, and in 2023 (until end of October), 27,253 have been sold in the UK



### NISSAN LEAF

- Launched in 2010, the Nissan LEAF is the car that sparked it all and was the world's first mass-market electric vehicle (EV)
- Second generation Nissan LEAF launched in 2018
- Nissan LEAF went into production at Nissan Sunderland Plant in 2013
- More than 270,000 Nissan LEAFs have been built in Sunderland
- More than 650,000 units of the Nissan LEAF have been sold worldwide since it was first launched, of which more than 260,000 have been sold in Europe to date
